Submission Guidelines: Panel proposals should include the following (as mentioned in the MS word template):

1. Title of the Proposal.
2. Technical Description (Up to 350 words).
3. Panelists' Information: Name, affiliations, contact information and short biographies (150 words max. per panelist).
4. Moderator.
5. Recommended duration: 45-minutes or 75-minutes panel discussion followed by 15 minutes for Q&A.
6. Any other Relevant Information. Brief description (no more than 200 words) of the contents, highlighting the innovative aspects of the proposal and its relevance for IECON audience.

- Significant industry involvement
- Industrial application oriented
- Collaborative cross-disciplinary topics or teams
- Creativity, clarity and quality of the panel proposal
- Follow the conference technical scopes.
